

Fabric Wine Coasters

Materials:

- Makes 12 coasters
- 6 Fat Quarters
- Thread
- Thin Cotton Batting (approximately 15" x 20")

Tools:

- Small rotary cutter
- Iron
- Circle Template

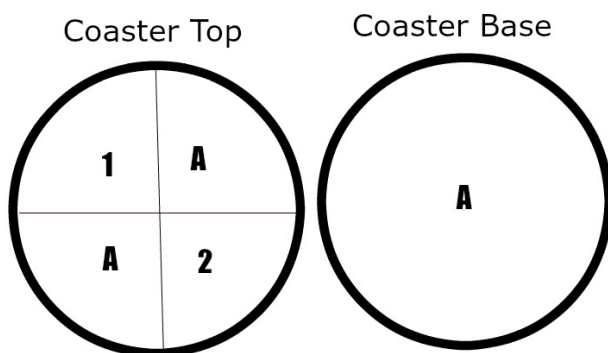


Instructions:

Print 5" circle template. Make sure your template is to scale using 1" square.

Each coaster will use five, 5" fabric circles and one batting circle. Four circles make the top and one for the base.

Choose two main fabrics (fabrics 1 & 2 in diagram) for each set of four of coasters.



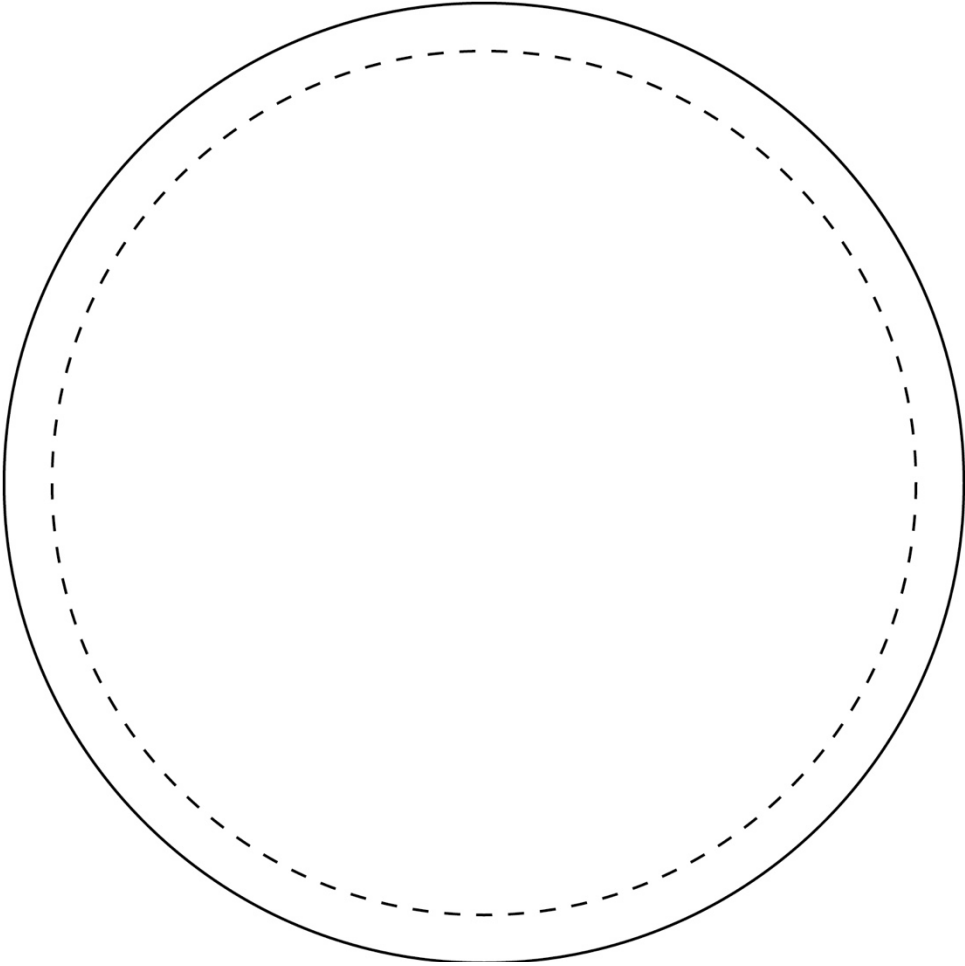
Individual coasters are comprised of one circle of each of your two main fabrics and three circles of one of the remaining four fabrics from your fat quarter selection (fabric A in diagram, A=fabrics 3-6). Fabric A will make two top sections and your coaster base.

For each coaster:

1. Using included template, cut five - 5" circles (1).
2. Press all four circles for the top of coaster in half with wrong sides together.
3. Stack fabric as follows: batting circle, coaster base right side up, all four top circles with visible side facing down (see photos 2-7 below).
4. Pin or clip all stacked circles in place (8).
5. Stitch a ¼" seam around entire circle (9).
6. Clip outside seam, around entire circle every ¼".
7. Turn right side out.
8. Press flat.
